Josh giggled. “But not the milk!”

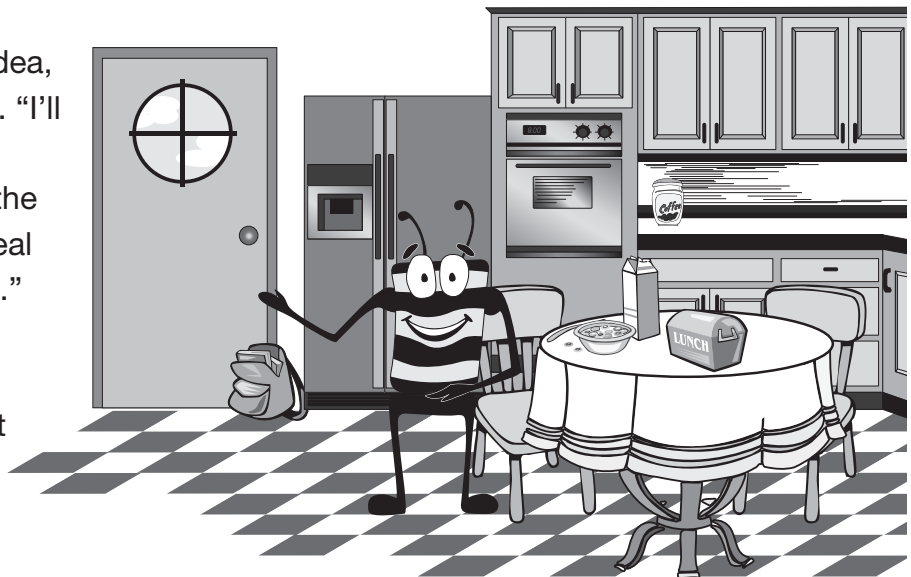
“No!” Bingzy laughed. “Not the milk!”
